

- **1 Timothy 6:16** Who **only** hath **immortality**, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom *be* honour and power everlasting. Amen.

Yes, only the Lord Jesus Christ has immortality. So does this mean that Ann will never gain immortality? No, for she believed again the Apostle Paul in 1 Cor. 15 where he states,

- 1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- **1 Corinthians 15:52** In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- **1 Corinthians 15:53** For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.

1 Corinthians 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

1 Corinthians 15:55 O death, where *is* thy sting? O grave, where *is* thy victory?

This sting of death is hurting us all greatly today. However, God has given us a way out. In the future death will have no sting and the grave will no longer have the victory.

Because in Col 3, we read...

Colossians 3:2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

Colossians 3:3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

Colossians 3:4 When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.
