



# Baptism Prison





#### Jeremiah a Prophet

♦ KJV Jeremiah 38:1 Then Shephatiah the son of Mattan, and Gedaliah the son of Pashur, and Jucal the son of Shelemiah, and Pashur the son of Malchiah, heard the words that Jeremiah had spoken unto all the people, saying, 2 Thus saith the LORD, He that remaineth in this city shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth forth to the Chaldeans shall live; for he shall have his life for a prey, and shall live. 3 Thus saith the LORD, This city shall surely be given into the hand of the king of Babylon's army, which shall take it. 4 Therefore the princes said unto the king, We beseech thee, let this man be put to death: for thus he weakeneth the hands of the men of war that remain in this city, and the hands of all the people, in speaking such words unto them: for this man seeketh not the welfare of this people, but the hurt.1 (Jer. 38:1 KJV)

#### Jehoahaz (2 Chr. 36:1 KJV)

- KJV 2 Chronicles 36:12 And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD his God, and humbled not himself before Jeremiah the prophet speaking from the mouth of the LORD.
- KJV 2 Chr. 35:25 And Jeremiah lamented for Josiah: and all the singing men and the singing women spake of Josiah in their lamentations to this day, and made them an ordinance in Israel: and, behold, they are written in the lamentations.

Now it must be affirmed, and it will be conceded by all Bible students, that an interpretation of this passage which is to be accepted as satisfactory—

- 1. Must take all the words in their natural meaning and Scriptural usage.
- 2. Must be uniform and consistent in its translation.
- 3. Must give due weight to the inexorable laws of grammatical construction.
- 4. Must give the passage its logical place in the context.
- 5. Must harmonize it with the general teaching of the whole

Epistle, and not merely cleverly explain it as though it were an isolated passage; but must show that it is absolutely necessary to the argument.
