Ps 7:11 God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day

Christ as the Judge

John 5:22

For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

John 5:26-27

For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; ²⁷ and hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. Dan 12:2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth **shall awake**, some to everlasting life, and some to shame *and* everlasting contempt. ??

John 5:28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all? that are in the graves shall hear his voice, ²⁹ and shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. ?? Acts 24:15 ... and have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust. ??

Are the saved those who are called the just and the unjust?

Not justified and unjustified!

2 Cor 5:10 (saved)

For we must all? appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things *done* in *his* body, according to that he hath done, whether *it be* good or bad. (works?)

(What about the Body of Christ?)

Romans 14:10 (saved)

But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all ? stand before the judgment seat of Christ.

(What about the Body of Christ?

Hebrews 9:27-28 (saved)

And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment? ²⁸ so Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

Romans 5:18

Therefore as by the offence of one *judgment came* upon all men (in Adam) to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One *the free gift came* (also) upon all men unto justification (acquittal) of life.

Are all men judged at birth?

Are believers judged again at Conversion?

For unbelievers, is their judgement day the day they die ?

Those who die in Adam, the unsaved unbelievers Have judged themselves, They die in unbelief The power of the grave holds them for the second death. **Do they have a resurrection? No escape!** Do they have a final judgement? Lake of fire! Do they just perish with no hope?

Romans 8:1

There is therefore **now** no condemnation (judgement against) to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. ² For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. 22

Isaiah 26:19

Thy dead *men* shall live, *together with* my dead body shall they arise (resurrection). Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew *is as* the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

The grave has no power over the saved! Matt 16:18

Revelation 20:4-6 Overcomers

And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. ⁵ But the rest of the dead (believers) lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This *is* the first (former of two) resurrection. ⁶ Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. (Israel)

Dan 12:1-2

And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation *even* to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. ² And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some (former) to everlasting life, and some (latter) to shame (rebuke) and everlasting contempt (abhorring).

1 Thes 4:14-17 Acts believers or Rev overcomers?

For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him (God will through Jesus bring with Him). ¹⁵ For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel (Michael), and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: ¹⁷ then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever (always) be with the Lord. (Third resurrection)

Revelation 20:11-15 All of the (saved) dead

And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. ¹² And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. ¹³ And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every (saved) man according to their works. ¹⁴ And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. ¹⁵ And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. (Not **Resurrected**)

The second death and lake of fire.

Only found in Revelation

The lake of fire is a figure of final annihilation. The unsaved are never resurrected. The unsaved are still in the grave (hell). The unsaved are not found in the book of life. Death is the enemy of the unsaved. Death and the grave (hell) have power. The beast and false prophet are ungodly systems. Satan is a spiritual being with powers of darkness. The second death is a second kind of death. It has nothing to do with death of human beings. It is the end of all powers that are not of God.

Only the saved are resurrected to life The grave has no power over the saved

Our old man (flesh) will perish Our new man will be raised with a new body

The unsaved have no resurrection. The grave has power to keep the unsaved

Only the saved are judged after resurrection. The unsaved have no judgement after death.

The saved can be just or unjust. Some can be condemned for their works.
