## Luke 2:1-39 Jesus

Birth, Circumcision, and Presentation of Jesus

Decree from Caesar Augustus 4 B.C. Before winter

Feast of Tabernacles 15th Tishri (Sept 29) 8 Days 22nd Tishri (Oct 6)

Shepherds abiding in the fields...and returned (before October)

Perfect gestation period 280 days

December 25, 5 B.C. 280 days September 29, 4 B.C.

Jesus born September 29, 4 B.C.

4 B.C. September 29 I5<sup>th</sup> Tishri

15<sup>th</sup> Tishri First Sabbath of the Feast of Tabernacles

"...and tabernacled among us" (John 1:14)

#### Lev 23:33-36

And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

- <sup>34</sup> Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto the LORD.
- <sup>35</sup> On the first day (Jesus' birth) shall be an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.
- <sup>36</sup> Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day (Jesus' circumcision) shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it is a solemn assembly; and ye shall do no servile work therein.

Jesus Born Sept 29, 4 B.C.

Jesus Circumcised the Eight Day Oct 6

41 days Nov 8 Jesus presented to the Lord in Jerusalem

Luke 2:39 They returned to Nazareth

GOLD - Symbol of earthly kingship

• FRANKINCENSE - Symbol of Godliness

MYRRH - Symbol of death


Roman Church, Anglican Church, Lutherans, etc

The Feast of the Epiphany 12 days January 6
Magi arrive at Bethlehem
Christ is manifested to the Gentiles

Also called Theophany or Three Kings' Day

Orthodox Church
January 7 Christ's Birth
January 19 Theophany: visible manifestation of God to man

#### Matt 2:16

Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently inquired of the wise men.

Then Herod, when he had privily called the wise men, enquired of them diligently what time the star appeared.


### In my opinion

Herod was told by the Magi that they had been traveling and following the star for about two years.

That is why he ordered all male infants two and younger to be killed.

Jesus could not have been two years old when the Magi came if Herod died 4 months after Jesus' birth.

King Herod the Great died late January 3 B.C.

4 months after Jesus was born


Shortly after ordering the slaughter

## The story of the wise men:

First to acknowledge the prophetic coming

First to acknowledge and worship the Saviour

Exposed the neglectful attitude of the Judeans

Gifts were prophetic of Jesus' life and purpose

Gifts provided many years of support for a faithful family
