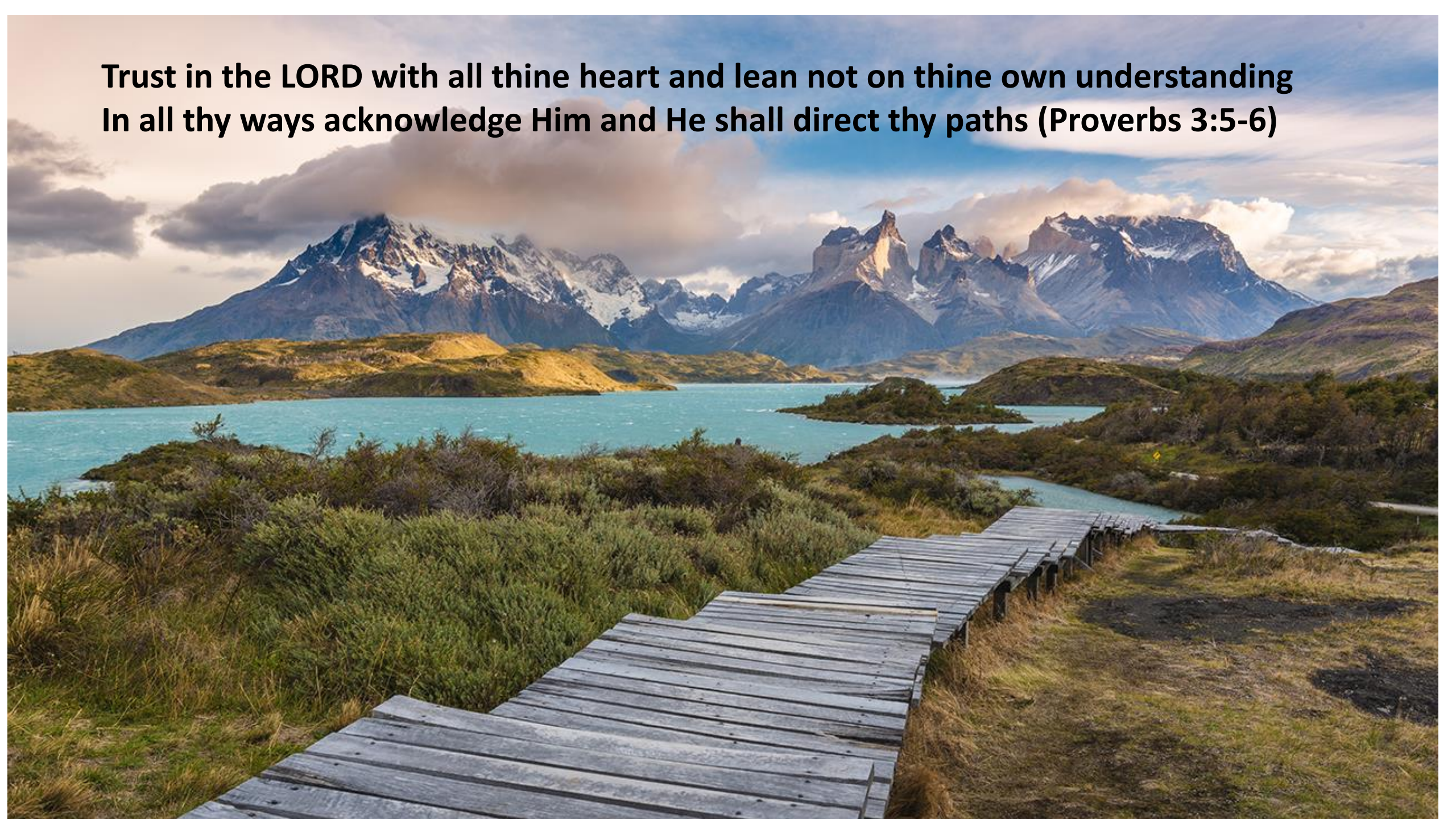

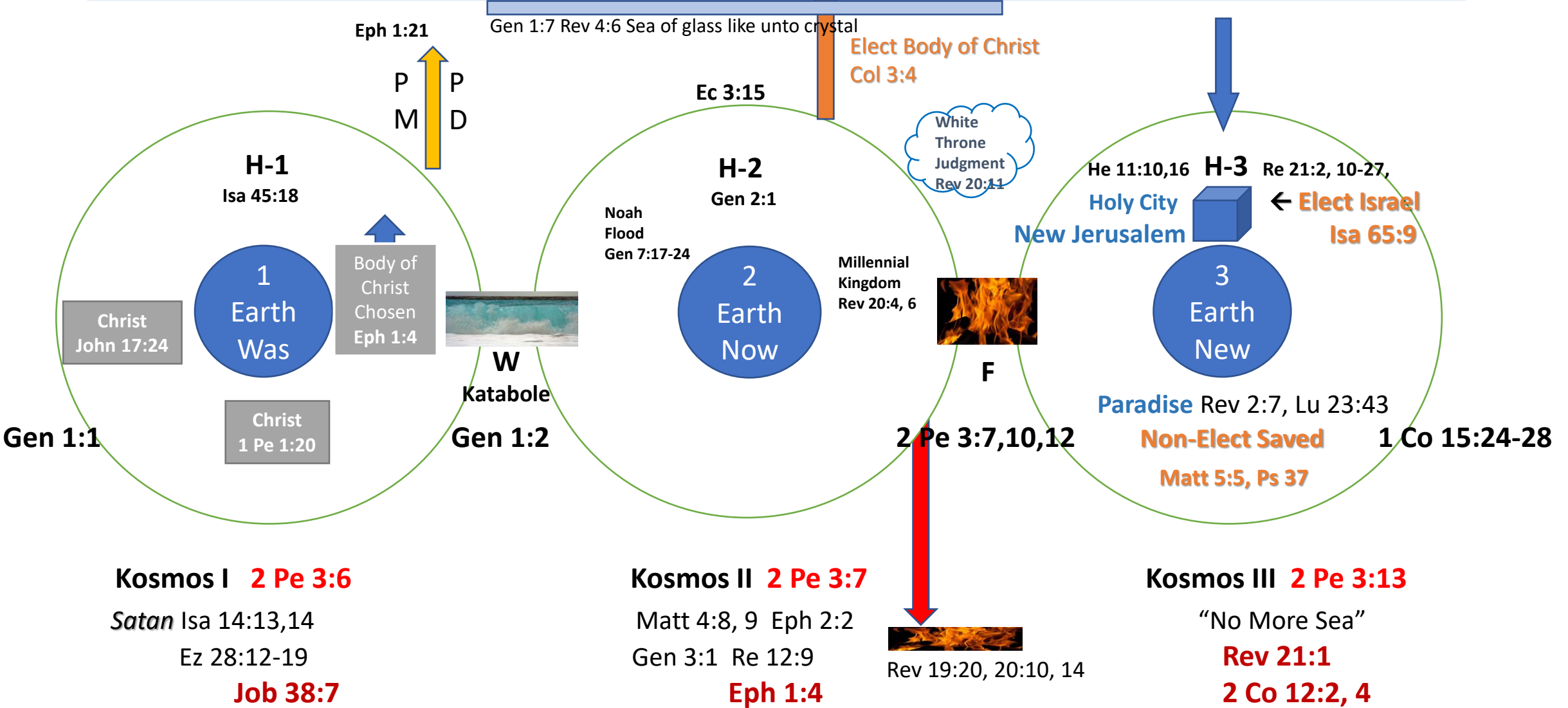

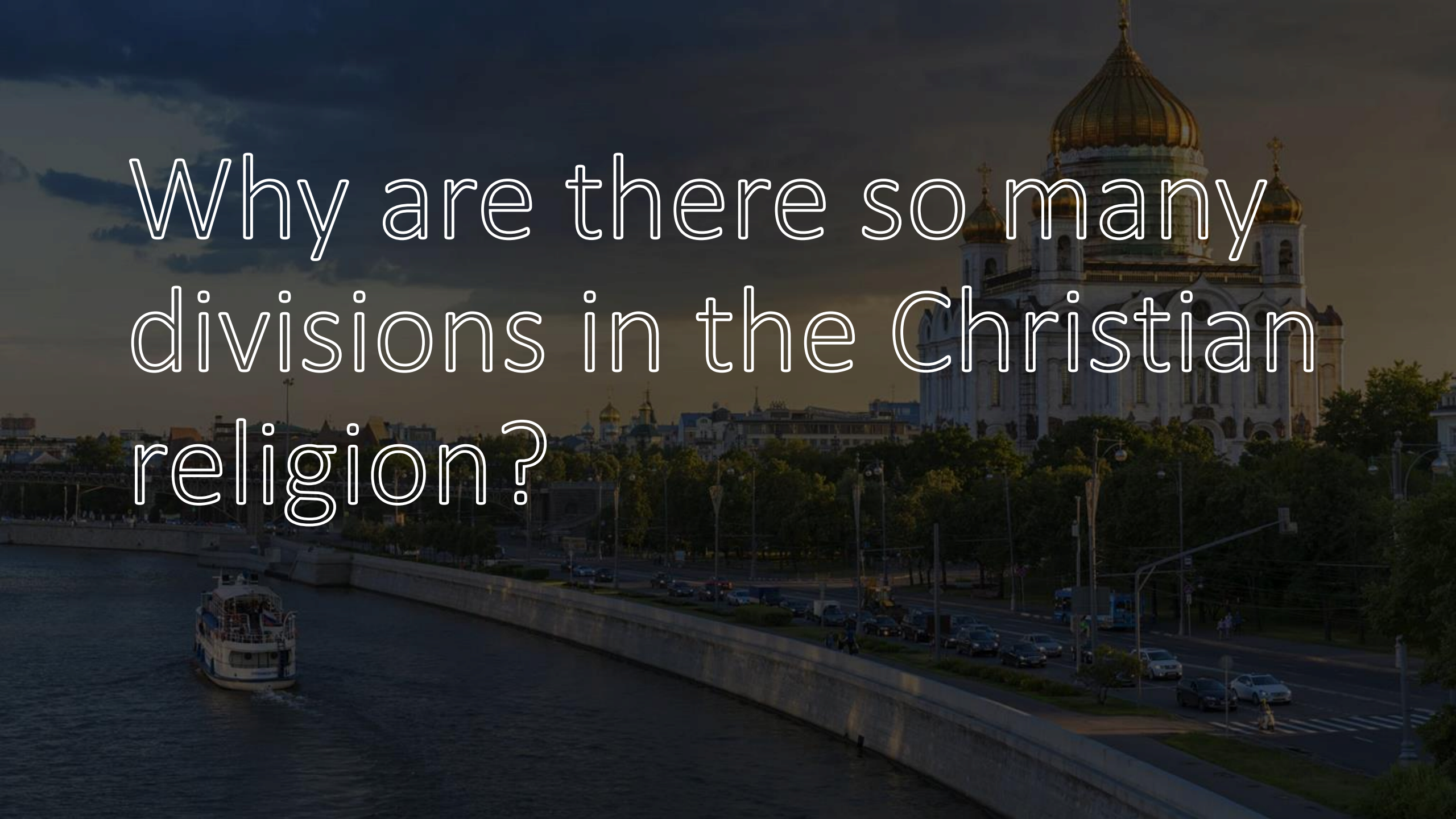


**Re = Again    Ligo = Bind**

What is the  
church?



In the Bible the Greek word ***ekklesia*** means a calling out and refers to people.

The English word “church” from Circe, the name of a pagan goddess means a place to worship a god or goddess.

***Ekklesia*** in the Bible means any calling out by God for a specific purpose.

The present ***ekklesia*** is the Body of Christ

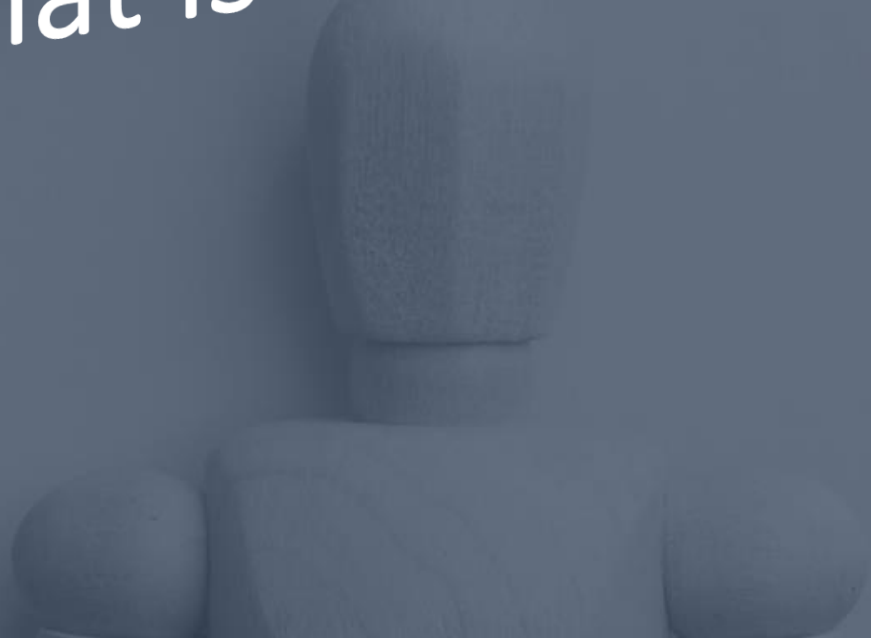
## John 4:23-24

What is the New Covenant?




**Jeremiah 31:31 (489 B.C. after Hosea 689-611 B.C.)**

**Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make  
a **new covenant** with the **house of Israel** and the **house of Judah**:**

**This shall be the covenant that I will make with the **house of Israel**:  
after those days saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward  
parts, and write it in their hearts, and will be their God, and they  
shall be My People.**

**I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.**
