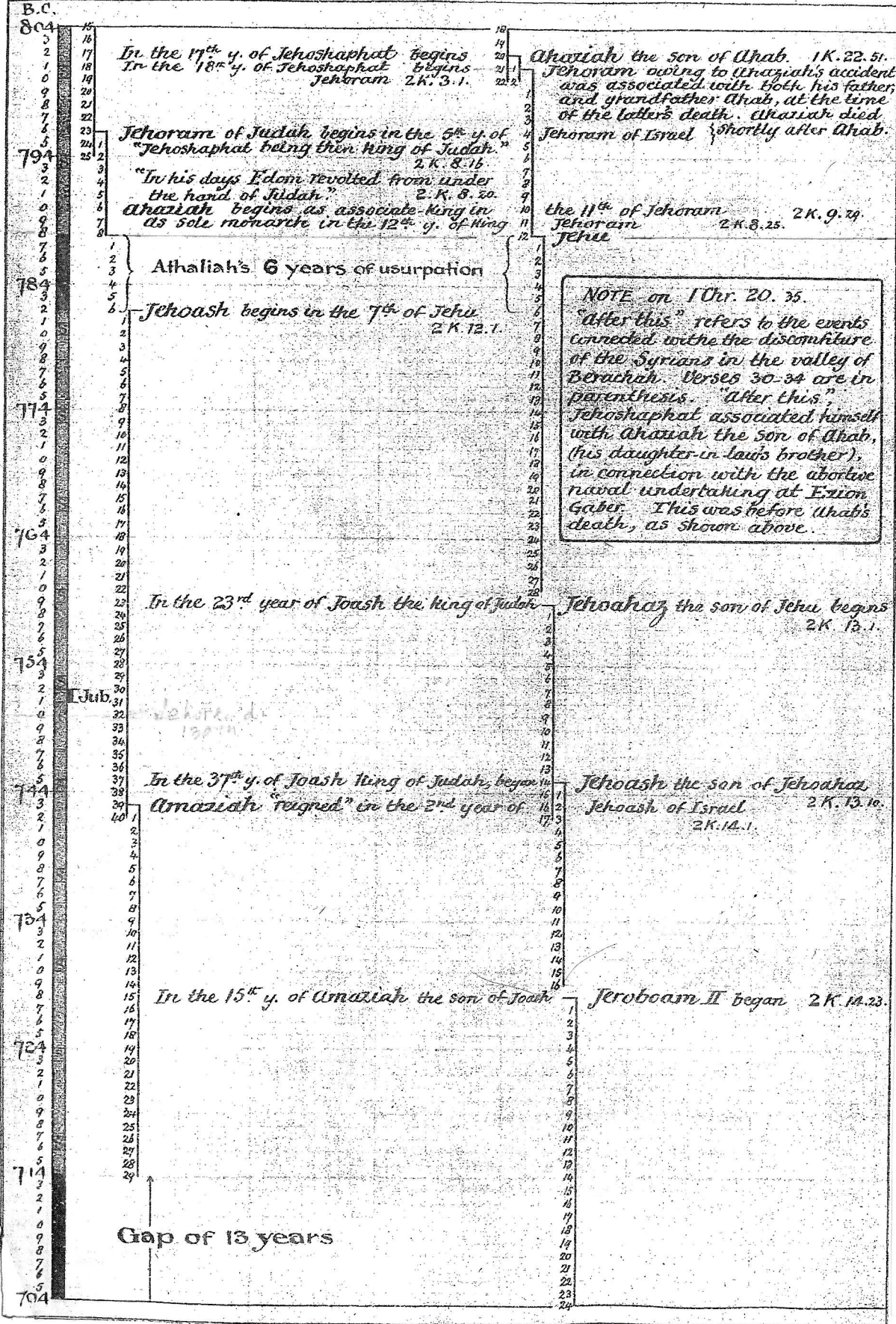

NOTE. The explanation of the statement in 2 Chr. 16.1, that Baasha came up against Judah 9 years after he was dead, is simple. The word translated "reign" (A.V. & R.V.) is not מָלַךְ (māh-lākh = to reign, as, e.g. in 1 Chr. 3.4.) but מַלְכוּת (mal-'chooth = kingdom. (cf. Num. 24.7.) The 36<sup>th</sup> y. of Asa's kingdom, dating from Rehoboam is therefore the 16<sup>th</sup> y. of his reign.

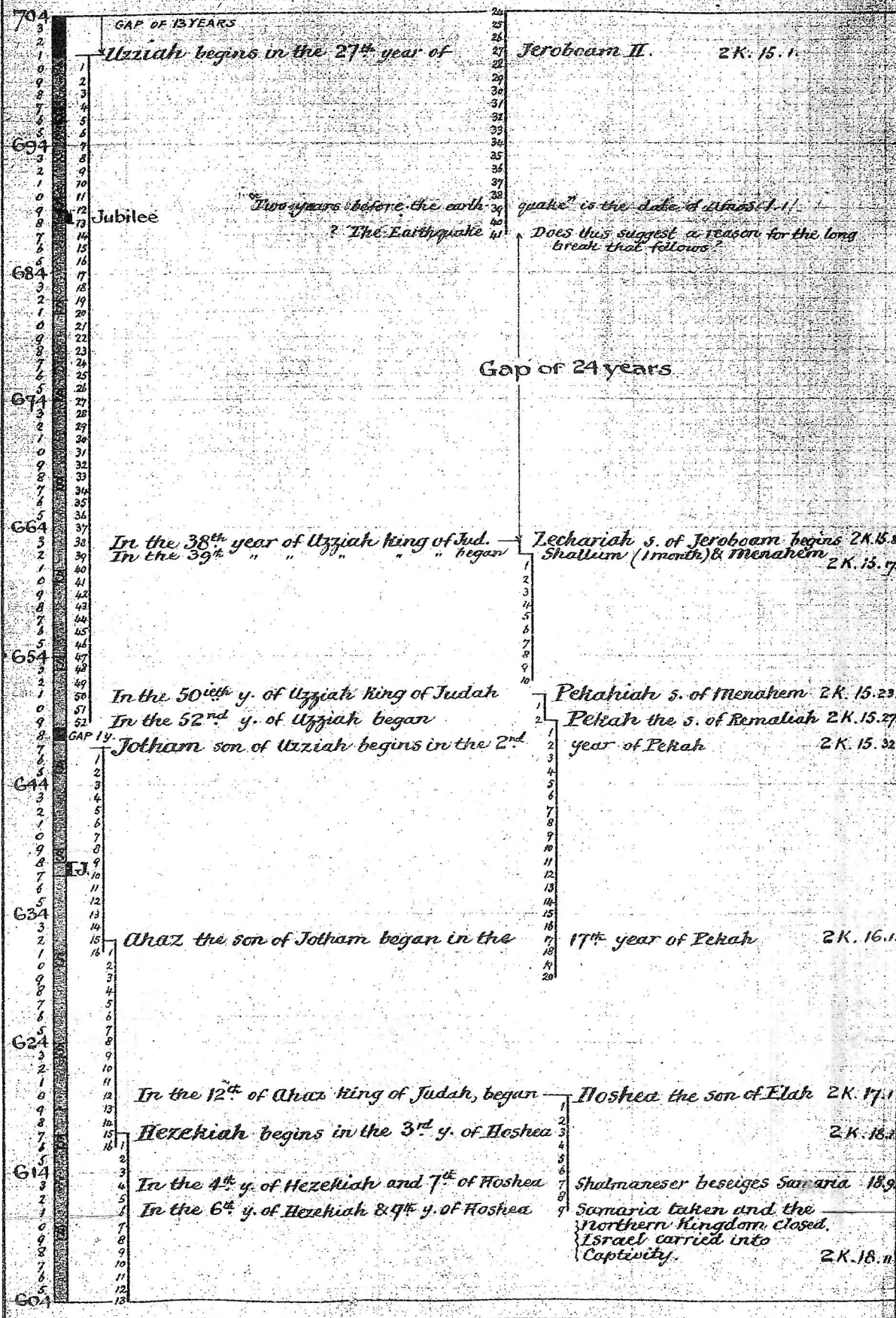

NOTE on 1 Chr. 20. 35.  
 "After this" refers to the events connected with the discomfiture of the Syrians in the valley of Berachah. Verses 30-34 are in parenthesis. "After this" Jehoshaphat associated himself with Ahaziah the son of Ahab, (his daughter-in-law's brother), in connection with the abortive naval undertaking at Ezion Gaber. This was before Ahab's death, as shown above.
