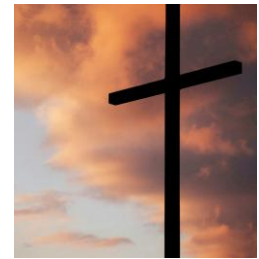

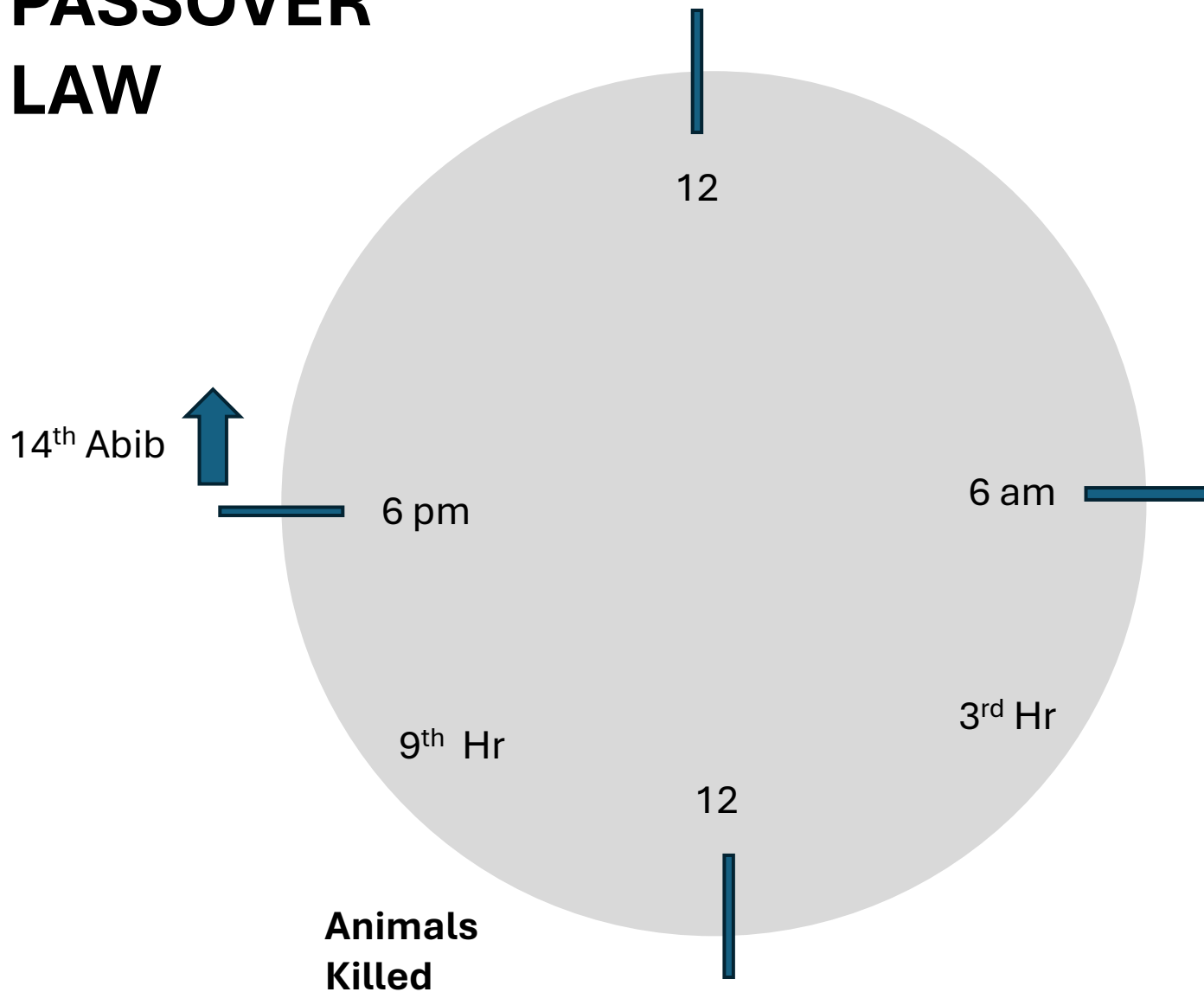

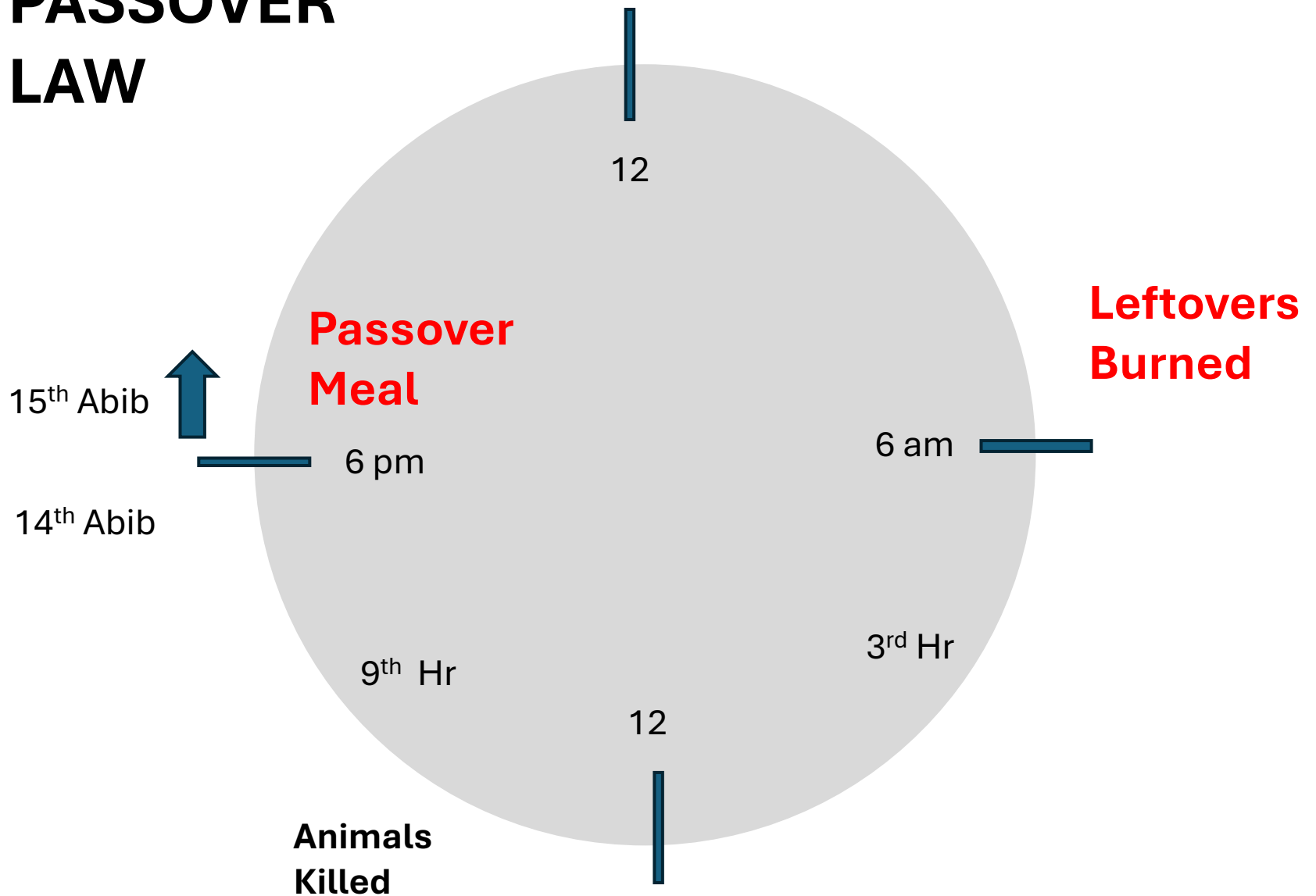

PASSOVER LAW



- ***Fourteenth day of the first month***
- ***Lamb without blemish***
- ***Kill it in the evening***
(or between the evenings)
- ***Eat it in the night***
(beginning of the fifteenth day)
- ***Burn all leftovers in the morning (15th)***
- ***This was to be a memorial of the release from Egypt***

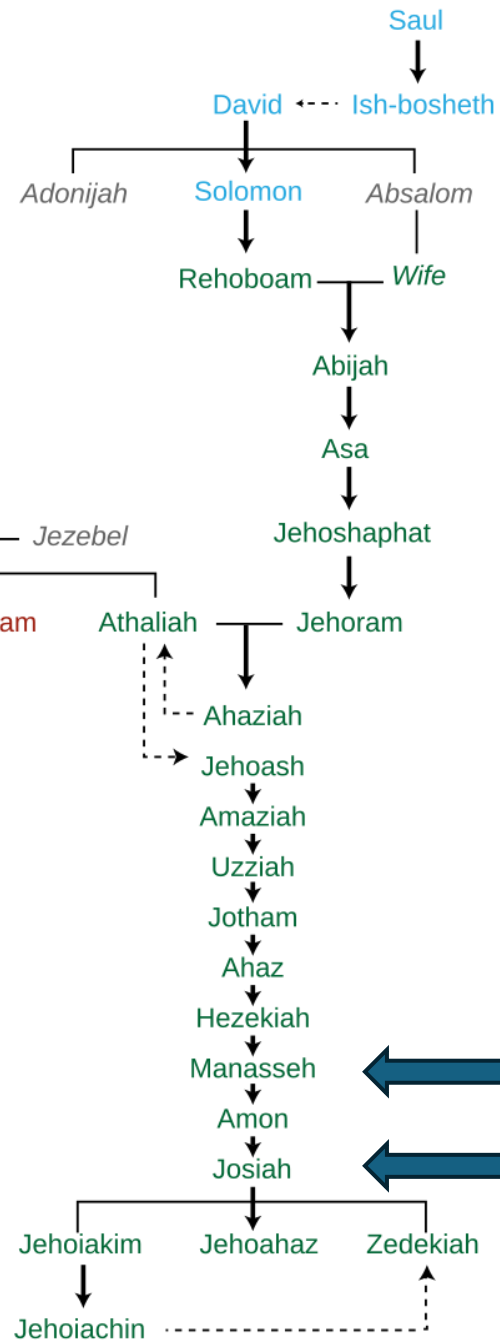

This meal would have been 24 hours before the appointed time for the Passover meal according to the law!

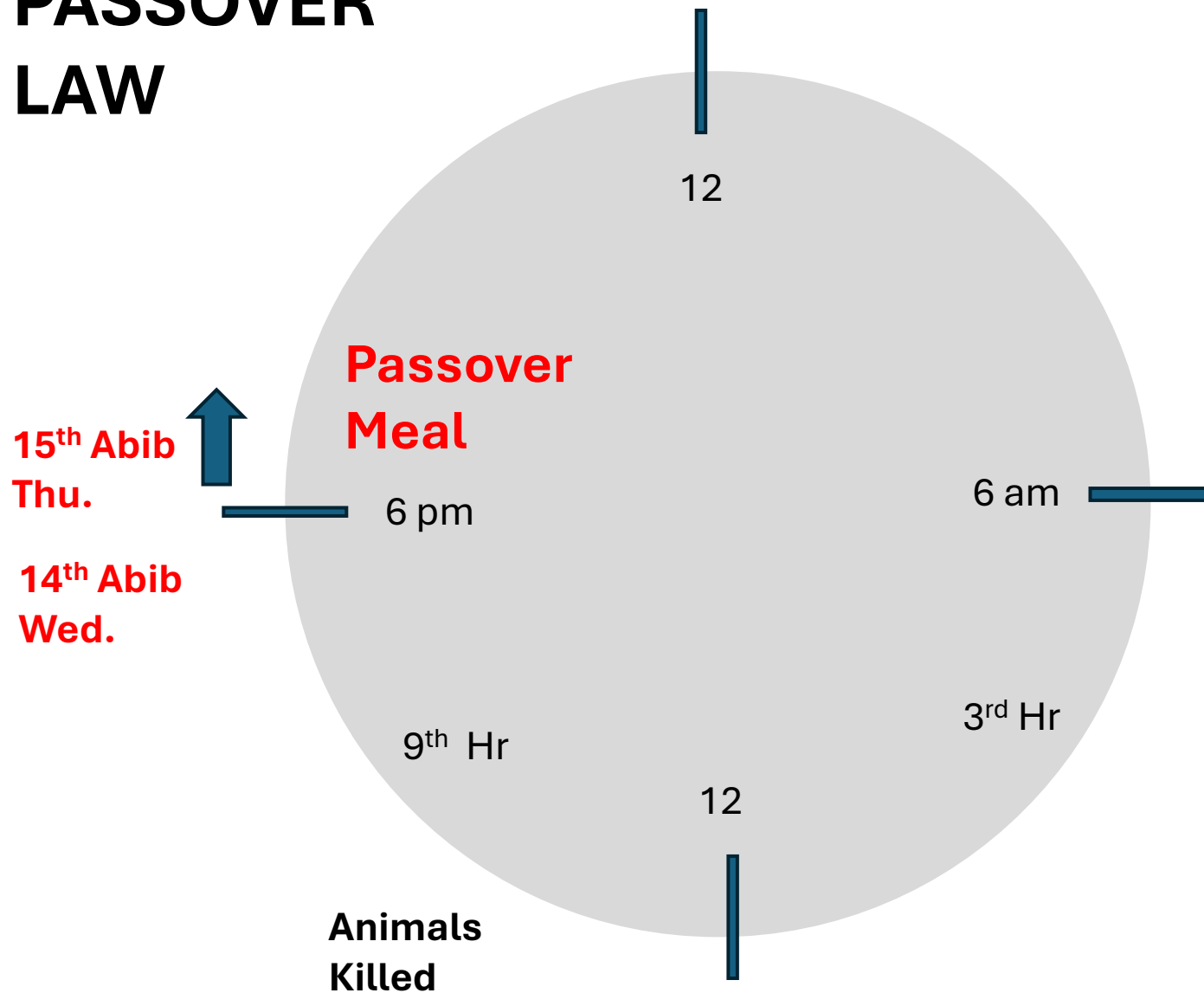

Luke 22:13-15

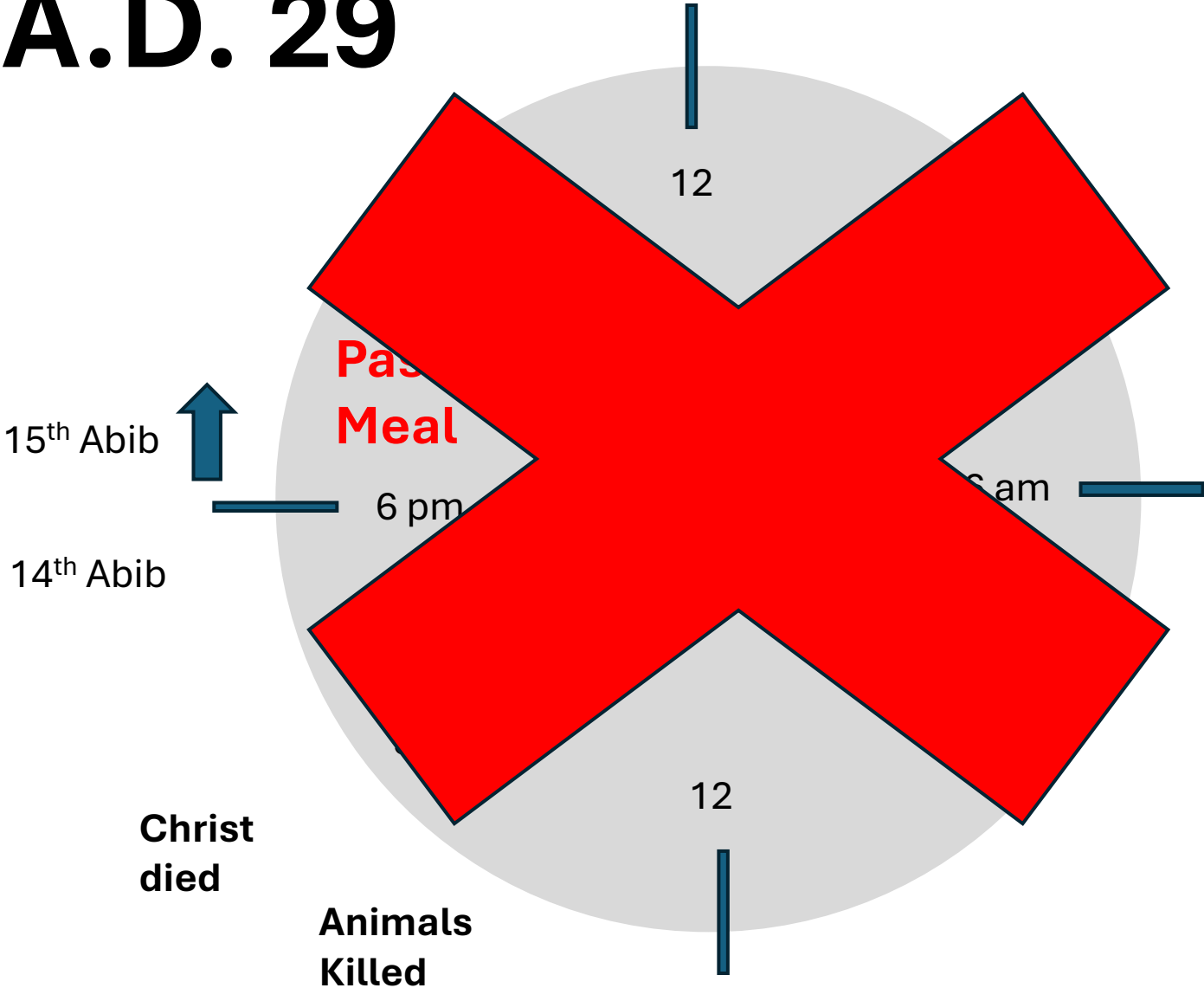
*And when the hour was come, he sat down, and the twelve apostles with him. ¹⁵ And he said unto them, **With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer**: ¹⁶ for I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.*

The Lord's Last Supper initiated a significant change in God's administration immediately before the cross... but on the same day as the cross.

Eph 2:15

*¹⁵ having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in **ordinances**; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;*

Col 2:14

*¹⁴ blotting out the handwriting of **ordinances** that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;*

Col 2:20-22

*Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to **ordinances**,
²¹ (touch not; taste not; handle not; ²² which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?*

**The PASSOVER was not mentioned
during The Acts or after The Acts
except by Paul describing the change.**

1 Cor 5:7-8

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us: ⁸ therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the

unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Heb 10:4 *But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. ⁴For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.⁵Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: ⁶in burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure. ⁷Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God. ⁸Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law; ⁹then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. **He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second. ¹⁰By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.***



Gen 14:18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.

At this meal Christ brought forth bread and wine and became the High Priest and offered Himself as the Lamb of God.

The first supper not according to the law

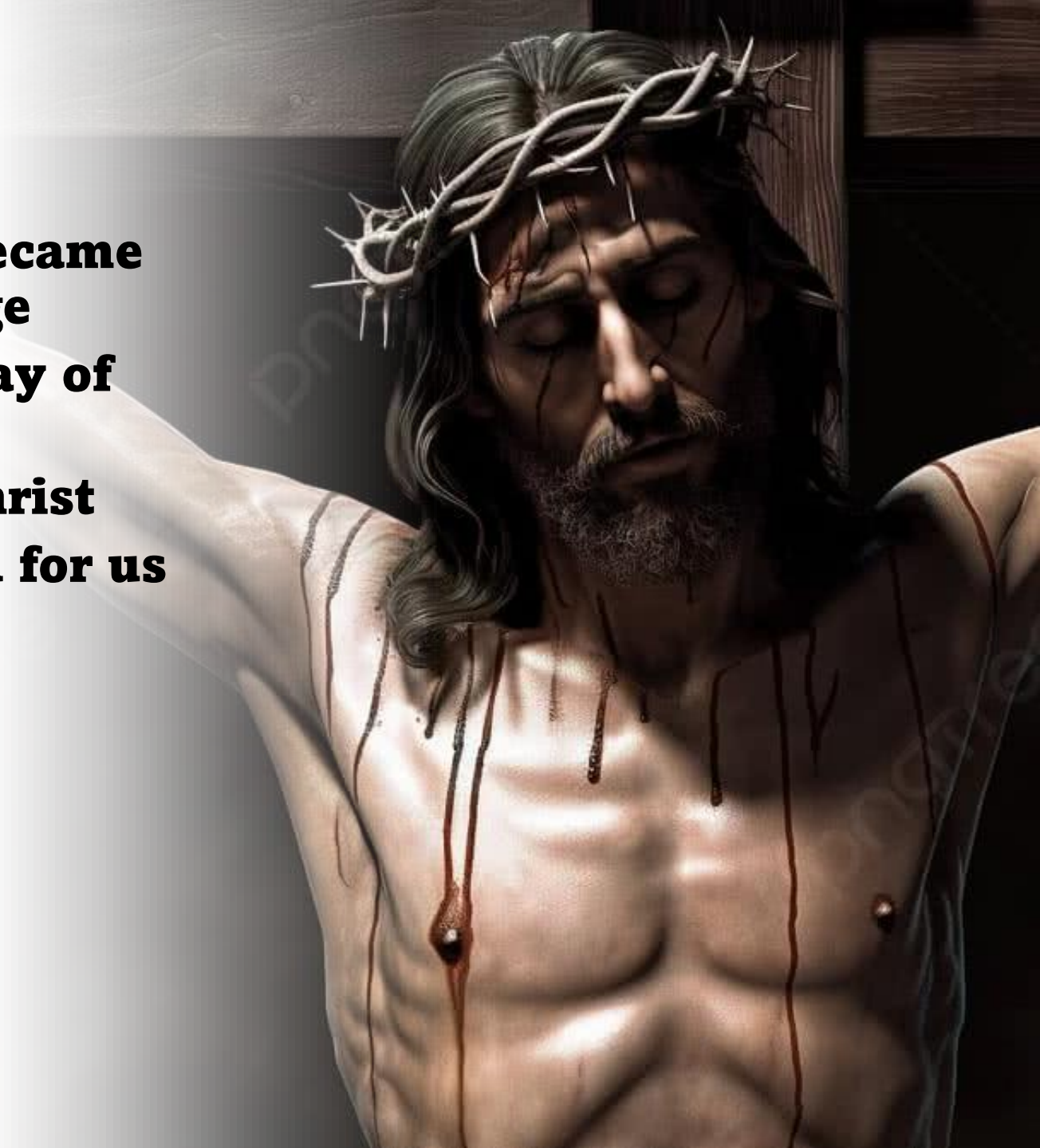
The first supper when Christ became High Priest

First supper of freedom from covenants.

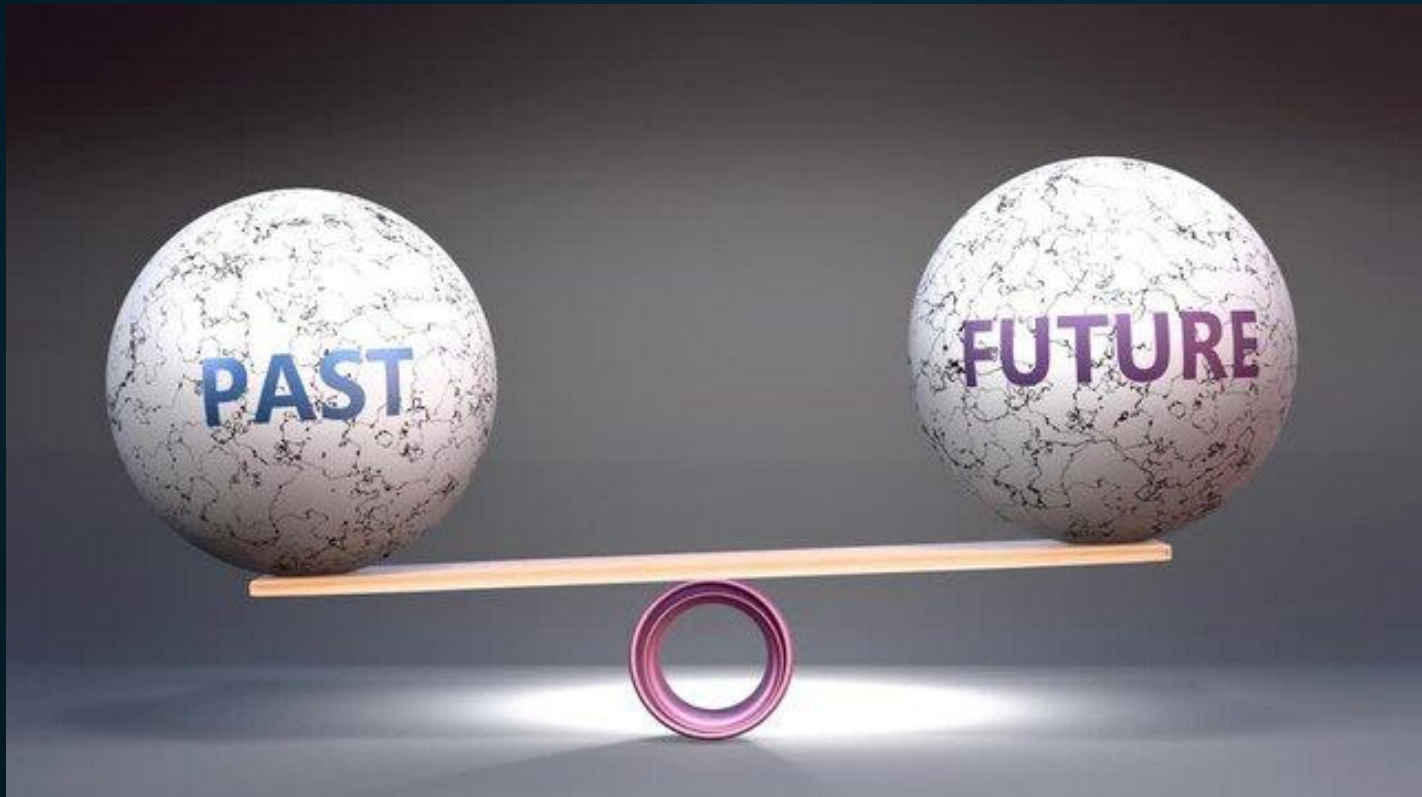
