



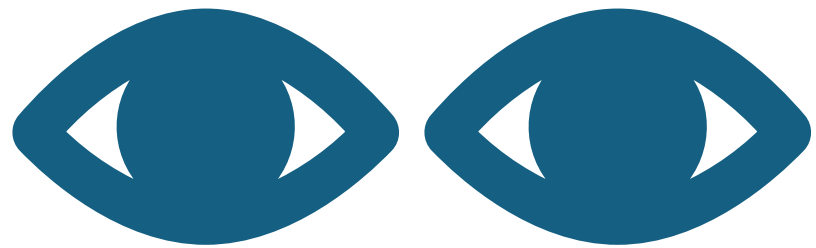

The Eye-Brain Connection: How Vision and the Brain Are Linked

The **eye-brain connection** is one of the most complex and vital partnerships in the nervous system. While the eyes appear as separate sensory organs, they are **direct extensions of the brain** and are deeply integrated into how we perceive, think, and respond to the world.

During embryonic development, the eyes form from **optic vesicles** that emerge from the forebrain (neural tube). The retina, the light-sensitive layer at the back of the eye, develops as part of the central nervous system (CNS). This shared origin means the retina is considered brain tissue.

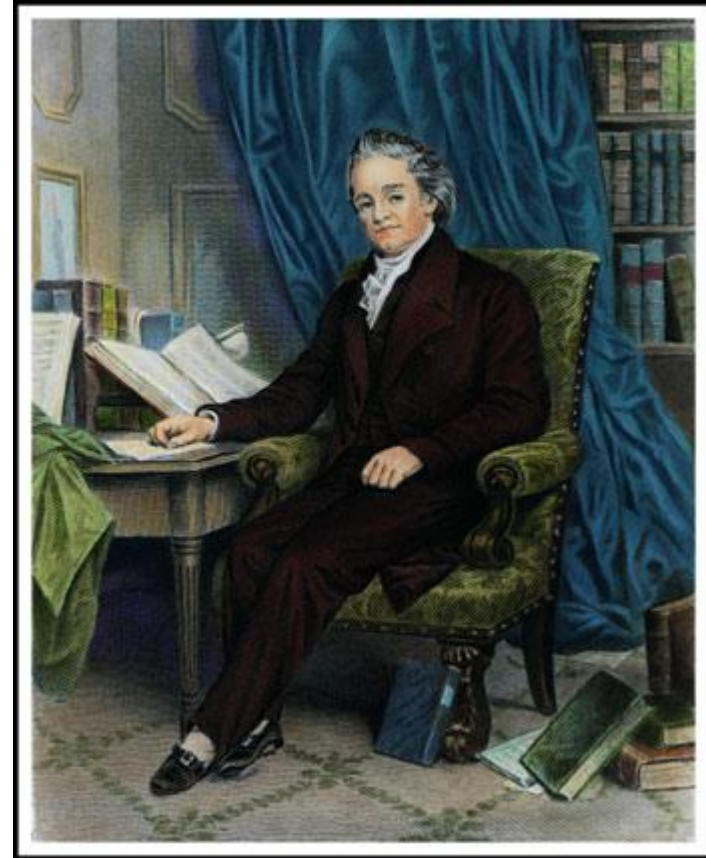

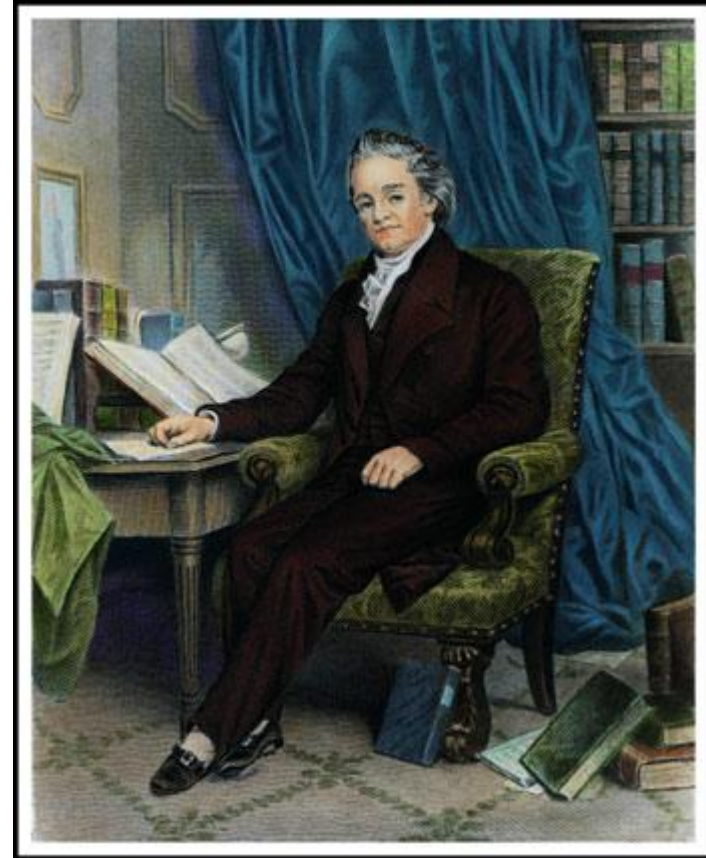

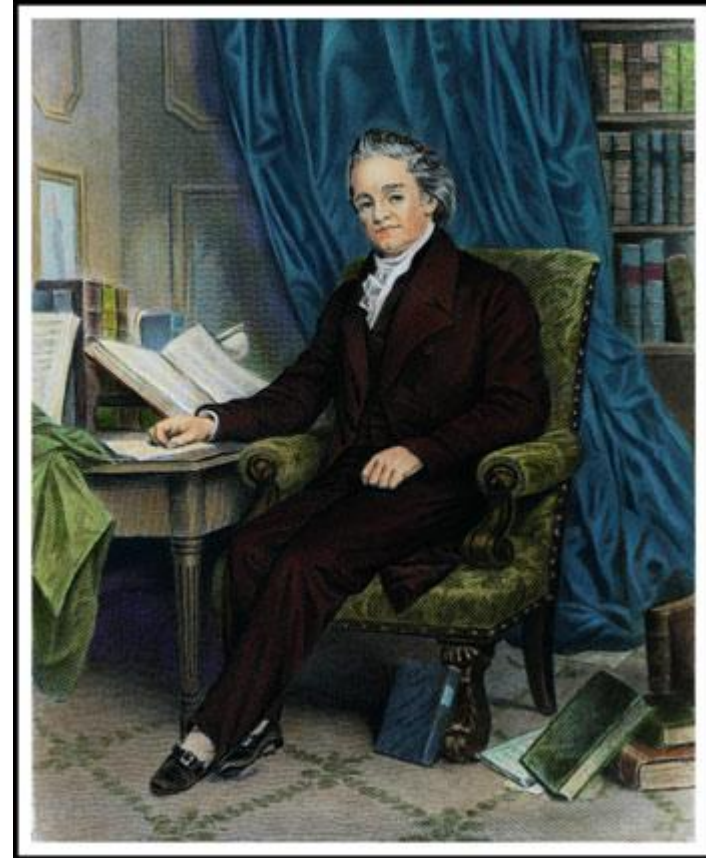
